

Maryville High School operates on a block schedule in which students are enrolled in four 90-minute classes per semester, completing up to eight credits per year.



In 2016, Tennessee introduced the TN Promise, a scholarship and mentoring program for TN high school graduates to attend a two-year community college or college of applied technology tuition free. While MHS has seen a change in four-year college enrollment, the overall college-going rate remains consistent.

Grading Policy and Rank


MHS will not provide numerical student ranking. Instead, our school will use the following Latin System for honors recognition:

- Summa Cum Laude: 4.45 and above
- Magna Cum Laude: 4.25 4.44
- Cum Laude: 3.95 4.24

Per the Tennessee Department of Education uniform grading policy, AP courses are given an additional 1.0 quality points; Statewide Dual Credit and Dual Enrollment courses are given an additional 0.75 quality points; Honors, Local Dual Credit and Industry Certification courses are given an additional 0.5 quality points. The transcript includes both a weighted and unweighted GPA.


